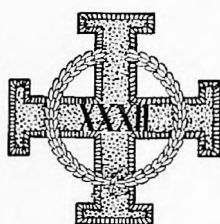

## ALLEGIANCE

We derive our charters from the Supreme Council of the Thirty-third and last Degree for the Southern Jurisdiction of the United States of America (Mother Council of the World) whose See is at the Grand Orient of Charleston, State of South Carolina, unto whom we acknowledge and yield Allegiance.

## PREFATORY

The Supreme Council of the Southern Jurisdiction of the United States, under whose authority we work, disclaims all jurisdiction or control over the degrees of Entered Apprentice, Fellow Craft and Master Mason, and accepts only applicants for its degrees who are Master Masons in good standing in lodges recognized by the Grand Lodge of the State in which the applicant resides.

The Ineffable degrees, as conferred in this jurisdiction, begin with the Fourth and extend through the Fourteenth, and are conferred in Lodges of Perfection.

The Historical and Religious degrees begin with the Fifteenth and extend through the Eighteenth, and are conferred in Chapters of Rose Croix.

The Chivalric and Philosophic degrees begin with the Nineteenth and extend through the Thirtieth, and are conferred in Councils of Kadosh.

The Official degrees are the Thirty-first and Thirty-second, and are conferred in the Consistory.

The Thirty-third, and last, Masonic degree, is only conferred by the Supreme Council and is executive in its character, and only conferred as an Honorary or Official degree on those who have by long and arduous service in the Masonic vineyard attained distinction.

## SECRETARY'S BULLETIN

### QUALIFICATIONS

The only necessary qualification for the Scottish Rite Degrees is to be an affiliated Master Mason in good standing and a resident of Texas for one year. If Lodge membership is held outside of Texas, a certificate of good standing or receipt for dues must accompany the petition.

It is not required that the Degrees in all of the different Bodies shall be taken at one session. A candidate may stop at the close of any one Body, if it is not convenient to proceed further.

### ANNUAL DUES

The Statutes of the Supreme Council provide that Annual Dues are payable in advance January 1st of each year for calendar year.

### MEMBERS

Article IX, Section 9 of the Statutes of the Supreme Council, specifically states: "That no Brother of this Jurisdiction shall be permitted to visit or attend his own or any Subordinate Body of this Rite unless he be in possession of the Identification Card for the current year."

Members of these Bodies will govern themselves accordingly.

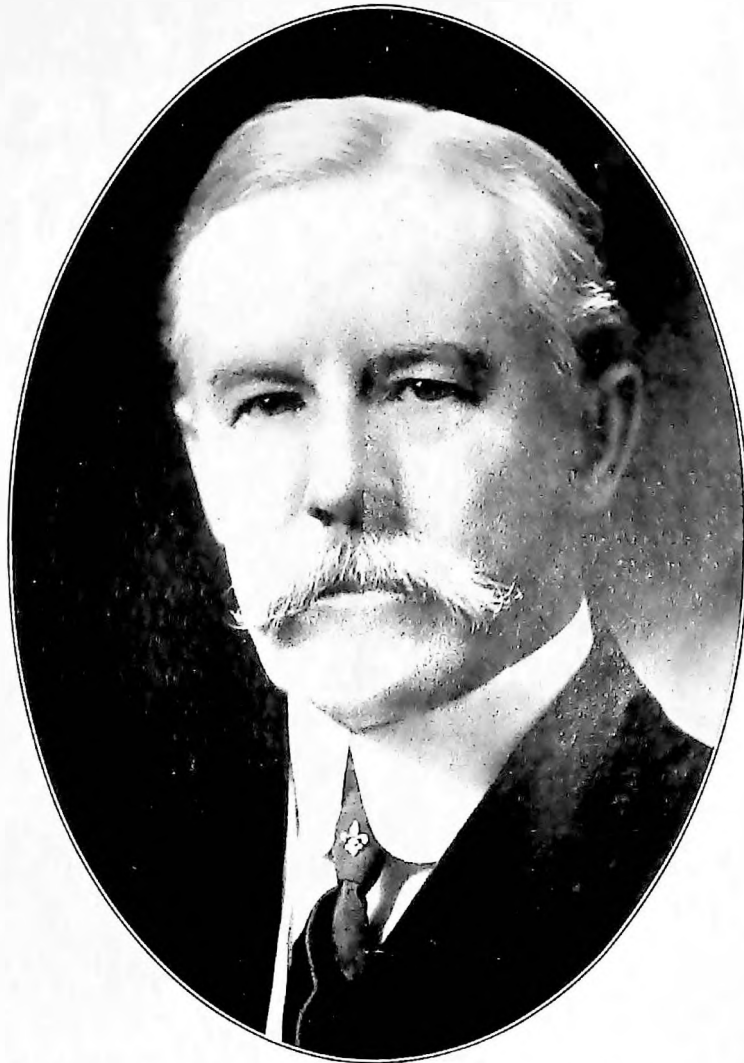

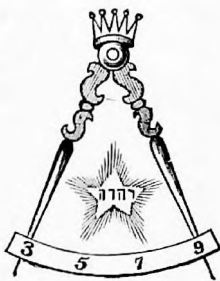

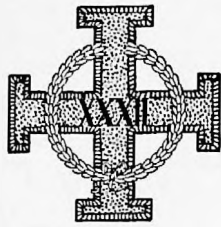
