JOHN CHARLES ECKERT
32°, K.C.C.H.
1890-1975



Brother Eckert was born in New York City, April 22, 1890. He left school at the age of 14 to become an apprentice with a contractor for whom his father was Superintendent of Construction. He continued his education by attending night school as required by law in New York City. In 1907, he moved to Riesel, Texas.

John married Clara Archer of Riesel, Texas on July 5, 1913. They have four children—John Charles Eckert, Jr., Mrs. Stanton Weiss, William A. (Booty) Travis and Travis A. Eckert.

John C. Eckert was a member of the United First Methodist Church of Austin, Texas, and a member of the Board of Stewards for over forty years. He was active in Boy Scout work, having been a Troop Committeeman for over 25 years. He was extremely active in the Austin Chapter of DeMolay having served on the Advisory Council for many years.

Brother Eckert had an outstanding Masonic record. He was Raised in Riesel Lodge No. 835, A.F. & A.M., October 7, 1911.

He was made a Scottish Rite Mason in Austin Consistory, April 14, 1925. He served as Venerable Master, Fidelity Lodge of Perfection, 1947; as Wise Master, Philip C. Tucker Chapter of Rose Croix, 1925; as Commander, James D. Richardson Council of Knights Kadosh, 1945; as Master of Kadosh, Austin Consistory, 1947. He was elected for a five year term on the Austin Scottish Rite Executive Committee in 1943. In 1949, he received the rank and decoration of Knight Commander of the Court of Honour.

Brother Eckert received the Chapter and Council Degrees in 1920. He served as Deputy Grand High Priest, District 21, in 1947 and again in 1951. He was Created a Knight Templar in 1921 and served as Commander of Colorado Commandery No. 4 in 1933.

Brother Eckert was Created a Noble of the Mystic Shrine in 1922. He was a very active Shriner and was made a Life Member of the Ben Hur Patrol after serving as President from 1940 through 1946. Brother Eckert received his 50-year recognition in his Blue Lodge, in the Scottish Rite, in the York Rite and in the Shrine.

To the memory of our friend and Brother, John Charles Eckert, this 1976 Spring Reunion Class of the Austin Scottish Rite Bodies is affectionately dedicated.

To The Candidate

You are about to enter the Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, having been chosen by your Brethren for that high honor. It is not an idle step. Scottish Rite Masonry is a philosophy of life, teaching the relations which you should sustain toward your fellow man, as well as your relations to God, and the ceremonies should be approached reverently, and with earnestness of purpose. If you have any other purpose than making more of yourself as a man—a better citizen, and a more useful member of society,—you are making a mistake in knocking at these portals. If, however, you bring a receptive mind and a sensitive heart to these degrees, you will indeed be a wiser and a better man. Many men have been reborn, intellectually and spiritually, during the conferring of these Degrees. It is the hope and prayer of the Masters and other members of these Bodies that your experience may be rich, significant and profitable.

Secretary's Bulletin

An applicant for the degrees in this Valley must be an affiliated Master Mason in good standing. He must have passed a satisfactory examination in the esoteric work of the Master Mason's Degree. He must have been a resident of the State of Texas for six months. If lodge membership is held outside of Texas, a certificate of good standing or receipt for dues for the current year must accompany the petition. Forfeiture of rights as a Master Mason for any reason works a forfeiture *ispo facto* of all rights in the Scottish Rite.

It is not required that the degrees in all of the different Bodies shall be taken at one session. A candidate may stop at the close of any one Body, if it is not convenient to proceed further.

PATENTS

Handsomely executed patents (in English) will be furnished all new members who attain the Thirty-second degree. They are issued under the seal of the Supreme Council of the Southern Jurisdiction of the United States of America, and will be mailed from the Secretary's office in Austin approximately eight weeks after the close of the Reunion. A picture and list of the members of the Class will also be furnished those completing the thirty-second degree.

RING 14°

Perfect Elus (14°) of this Jurisdiction should wear the ring of the degree on the third finger of the left hand (not counting the thumb); it should be a flat gold band; engraved within the ring the motto the degree, "*Virtus Junxit Mors Non Separabit*" (Whom Virtue Unites Death Cannot Separate). The cost of this ring is included in the fees.

ADMISSION BY CARD ONLY

Brethren will please take notice that, in accordance with the Statutes of the Supreme Council and under our By-Laws, a Brother not in possession of an identification card for the current year cannot be admitted to the meetings of the Reunion or to the Bodies of the Rite. Identification cards must be presented to the registration committee. **THIS RULE IS IMPERATIVE.**

Identification cards can only be issued by the Secretary, upon payment of dues in full, including the calendar year.

VISITORS

The law requires all visitors to have properly authenticated patents or letters of credence, together with identification cards, from Bodies recognized by and in relations of amity with the Supreme Council of the Southern Jurisdiction, Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite of the United States of America.

SUSPENSION IN BLUE LODGE

If a member is suspended in his Blue Lodge for non-payment of dues, or other cause, he automatically loses his membership in the Scottish Rite Bodies.
