SECRETARY'S BULLETIN

An applicant for the degrees in this Valley must be an affiliated Master Mason in good standing. He must have passed a satisfactory examination in the esoteric work of the Master Mason's Degree. He must have been a resident of the State of Texas for six months. If lodge membership is held outside of Texas, a certificate of good standing or receipt for dues for the current year must accompany the petition. Forfeiture of rights as a Master Mason for any reason works a forfeiture *ispo facto* of all rights in the Scottish Rite.

All Thirty-second Degree members are entitled to receive the New Age Magazine, published by the Supreme Council, without charge. New members will receive their copies just as soon as the addresses can be prepared by the Supreme Council in Washington, D. C. To The Candidate

You are about to enter the Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, having been chosen by your Brethren for that high honor. It is not an idle step. Scottish Rite Masonry is a philosophy of life, teaching the relations which you should sustain toward your fellow man, as well as your relations to God, and the ceremonies should be approached reverently, and with earnestness of purpose. If you have any other purpose than making more of yourself as a man—a better citizen, and a more useful member of society,—you are making a mistake in knocking at these portals. The Fatherhood of God and the Brotherhood of Man are emphasized in these degrees, and the student of the philosophy of the degrees as unfolded in their presentation, may get a lot of pleasure and much profit out of them. But it is up to you. "There is no royal road to learning," and there is no royal road to the mysteries of the Scottish Rite. It is an individual matter, and if you would be more useful to yourself and your community and to the Rite you must do more than merely listen to the unfolding of the lessons of the degrees. The light you must carry out into the world with you, and exemplify to those about you the beautiful lessons taught. If they are not put into effect in your life and character they are but so much "sounding brass and tinkling cymbals." The opportunity is before you to make yourself a Mason to whom your friends and neighbors will point as one worthy of the name.

If you become a Prince of the Royal Secret by receiving the Thirty-second Degree and are no better or wiser than when you began your journey, your investment of time and money will have been in vain. If, however, you bring a receptive mind and a sensitive heart to these degrees, you will indeed be a wiser and a better man. Many men have been reborn, intellectually and spiritually, during the conferring of these Degrees. It is the hope and prayer of the Masters and other members of these Bodies that your experience may be rich, significant and profitable.

PATENTS

Handsomely executed patents (in English) will be furnished all new members who attain the Thirty-Second degree. They are issued under the seal of the Supreme Council of the Southern Jurisdiction of the United States of America, and will be mailed from the Secretary's office in Austin.

ADMISSION BY CARD ONLY

Brethren will please take notice that, in accordance with the Statutes of the Supreme Council and under our By-Laws, a Brother not in possession of an identification card for the current year cannot be admitted to the meetings of the Reunion or to the Bodies of the Rite. Identification cards must be presented to the registration committee. **THIS RULE IS IMPERATIVE.**

Identification cards can only be issued by the Secretary, upon payment of dues in full, including the calendar year.

VISITORS

The law requires all visitors to have properly authenticated patents or letters of credence, together with identification cards, from Bodies recognized by and in relations of amity with the Supreme Council of the Southern Jurisdiction, Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite of the United States of America.

SUSPENSION IN BLUE LODGE

If a member is suspended in his Blue Lodge for non-payment of dues, or other cause, he automatically loses his membership in the Scottish Rite Bodies.

CAPS—THEIR SIGNIFICANCE

As the White Lambskin is the Badge of a Mason, so is the regulation cap the badge of a Scottish Rite Mason.

A purple cap indicates that the wearer is a 33° Sovereign Grand Inspector General and Active Member of the Supreme Council.

A white cap indicates a 33° Inspector General Honorary.

A red cap means 32° Knight Commander of the Court of Honour (KCCH).

A light blue cap means that the wearer has been a Scottish Rite Mason for fifty years or more.

A black cap indicates that the wearer has attained the 32nd Degree.

The Supreme Council has set forth a rule for the correct wearing of the cap. When wearing the cap it shall be considered to be a part of the apparel of the wearer and shall not be removed.

At the presentation of the flag, the cap shall remain in place, and the members shall stand at attention with the right hand over the heart.

During prayer the cap shall remain in place and the hands and arms shall be crossed as in the 18th Degree.

The wearing of caps is considered proper at Reunions, Scottish Rite meetings, Maundy Thursday services, etc. It is improper for the cap to be worn in cafes, bus stations, on the street, or in any other public place.

TEXAS SCOTTISH RITE INSTITUTIONS

Scottish Rite Dormitory—Austin

This institution had its inception in the mind and heart of the late Samuel Poyntz Cochran, 33°, Sovereign Grand Inspector General in Texas, and the original buildings were erected with funds donated by the various Scottish Rite Bodies of Texas.

The purpose of the Dormitory, as stated in the charter of the Holding Corporation, is to provide for the young women of Texas "suitable living quarters while attending the University, at a moderate price, and to surround them during their college days with wholesome, moral environment, and with the associations of home life, in addition to its comforts and conveniences."

The Scottish Rite Dormitory is a beautiful Georgian style building, designed to accommodate 358 girls. It is of fireproof construction, five stories high and equipped with steam heat and air conditioning, elevator, and individual room telephone service.

Admission is based on the fact that the father or some other relative is a member in good standing in a Masonic Lodge, or whose relative, if dead, was a member in such Masonic body at the time of his death.

Applications should be presented well in advance of the date that entrance is desired, as there is usually a waiting list on file.

An Endowment Fund for the permanent maintenance of the Dormitory has been recently established, only contributions from members of our Masonic Fraternity can be accepted.

Full information is available in the office of the Secretary of the local Bodies.

Admission is based on the following conditions:

1. That a child's home be in Texas.
2. That its parents be unable to bear the expense for treatment in a private hospital.
3. That its affliction be judged curable.
4. That it be under 15 years of age.

The Hospital was founded, and is operated solely for the purpose of treating Texas crippled children whose parents are not able to pay for treatment in non-charitable hospitals.

Many bequests have been made and are always appreciated. What a fine thing to remember the Scottish Rite Hospital in your will.
