They are issued under the Seal of the Supreme Council of the Southern Jurisdiction of the United States of America and will be mailed from the Secretary's office in Austin approximately eight weeks after the close of the Reunion. A picture and list of the members of the Class will also be furnished those completing the Thirty-Second Degree.

ADMISSION BY CARD ONLY

Brethren will please take notice that, in accordance with the Statues of the Supreme Council and under our By-Laws, a Brother not in possession of an identification card for the current year cannot be admitted to the meetings of the Reunion or to the Bodies of the Rite. Identification cards must be presented to the registration committee. THIS RULE IS IMPERATIVE.

Identification cards can only be issued by the Secretary upon payment of dues in full, including the calendar year.

VISITORS

The law requires all visitors to have properly authenticated patents or letters of credence, together with identification cards, from Bodies recognized by and in relations of amity with the Supreme Council of the Southern Jurisdiction, Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite of the United States of America.

This institution had its inception in the mind and heart of the late Samuel Poynts Cochran, 33°, Sovereign Grand Inspector General in Texas, and the original buildings were erected with funds donated by the various Scottish Rite Bodies of Texas.

The purpose of the Dormitory, as stated in the charter of the Holding Corporation, is to provide for the young women of Texas "suitable living quarters while attending the University, at a moderate price, and to surround them during their college days with wholesome, moral environment, and with the associations of home life, in addition to its comforts and conveniences."


The Scottish Rite Dormitory is a beautiful Georgian style building, designed to accommodate 344 girls. It is of fireproof construction, five stories high and equipped with steam heat and air conditioning, elevator, and individual room telephone service.

Admission is based on the fact that the father or some other relative is a member in good standing in a Masonic Lodge, or whose relative, if dead, was a member in such Masonic body at the time of his death.

Applications should be presented well in advance of the date that entrance is desired, as there is usually a waiting list on file.

An Endowment Fund for the permanent maintenance of the Dormitory has been recently established, only contributions from members of our Masonic Fraternity can be accepted.

SCHOOL FOR DYSLEXIC CHILDREN

The Scottish Rite Learning Center of Austin was opened March 6, 1989, in the basement of this Temple to teach dyslexic kids how to read and write. When you see this modest space, you can be pleased to know that you belong to an organization that is actively "making a difference".

Dyslexia is a neurological disorder, constitutional in origin, which causes youngsters to perceive our language symbols incorrectly. It cannot be "cured" but a successful method developed by the Texas Scottish Rite Hospital for Children in Dallas is available through our school to teach these youngsters how to cope with their problems and learn skills which will serve them successfully for the rest of their lives. We offer this program and pre-admission screening at no cost to the parents.
